

Easy Baby (Car-Seat) Blanket

Designed by Autumn Burns

Materials:

- 340 yards chunky weight yarn
- Size US 9, 24" circular needles
- US 10.5 straight needles
(for bind-off only)
- Darning needle

Gauge:

- 14 sts and 21 rows = 4"
in stockinette stitch



Finished Measurements

- 27.5" wide x 25" long

Abbreviations

C/o – cast on

BO – bind off

K – knit

P – purl

pm – place marker

sm – slip marker

rep - repeat

Sl1 WYIB – slip 1 stitch

knit-wise with yarn in

back

st – stitch(es)

RS – right side

WS – wrong side

Notes

The first stitch of every row will be Sl1 WYIB.

The cast on must be an odd number to work for the seed stitch pattern. Any odd number will work if you would like to make your blanket larger or smaller.

Instructions

With US 9 needles, C/O 91 stitches using long tail cast on method

Row 1 (*begin seed stitch*): Sl1 WYIB, **P1, K1** (rep to end of row, you should end with a knit stitch)

Rows 2 – 5: Sl1 WYIB, **P1, K1** (rep to end of row)

Row 6 (RS): Sl1 WYIB, P1, K1, P1, K1, pm, K81, pm, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1

Row 7 (WS): Sl1 WYIB, P1, K1, P1, K1, sm, P81, sm, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1



Row 8 (RS): Sl1 WYIB, P1, K1, P1, K1, sm, K81, sm, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1

Rep Rows 7 & 8 until blanket measurements reach desired dimensions

Begin final seed stitch border: Sl1 WYIB, **P1, K1** (rep to end of row); rep this row 4 more times

Bind Off: Using US 10.5 bind off in pattern (continue the seed stitch pattern as you bind off)

Weave in ends and block
