Bobblicious Hat by Lesley Edmondson

EXPERIENCE LEVEL Beginner

Quick to knit & so satisfying, our classic Bobblicious Hat is the perfect pattern to showcase your favorite super bulky weight yarn. Top with a faux fur pom pom for the ultimate wearable treat.







MATERIALS

1 skein Malabrigo Rasta (90 yards, 100g) or 90 yards super bulky weight yarn

Sample Yarn Colour 1 skein Malabrigo Rasta Almond Blossom

Size US 13, 16" circular needle (or size to obtain gauge)

1 set size US 13, double point needles

Ring stitch marker

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8 stitches/ 14 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch knit in the round, blocked

FINISHED SIZE

Hat circumference measures 20"

TECHNIQUES

Knitting in the round Working with double point needles Closing hat

SET-UP

Cast-on 43 stitches using long tail cast-on. Place marker & join to knit in round being careful not to twist.

BEGIN PATTERN

Rounds 1-12: *K1, P1* repeat to end of round

Rounds 13-20: Knit

Round 21: K1, M1, Knit to end of round

REDUCE FOR CROWN

Round 1: *K9, SSK* repeat to end of round

Round 2: Knit

Round 3: *K8, SSK* repeat to end of round

Round 4: Knit

Round 5: *K7, SSK* repeat to end of round

Round 6: Knit

Round 7: *K6, SSK* repeat to end of round

Round 8: Knit

Round 9: *K5, SSK repeat to end of round

Round 10: Knit

Round 11: *K4, SSK* repeat to end of

round

Round 12: Knit

Round 13: *K1, SSK* repeat to end of

round

Round 14: Knit

Round 15: *K1, SSK* repeat to end of

round

FINISHING

Using tapestry needle, draw yarn through remaining stitches twice, pull to close, then weave in ends.

Spray or steam block.

Top with pom pom and enjoy!

Notes

CO: Cast-on

K: Knit

P: Purl

M1 (Make 1): Using left needle, pick up the bar between stitches from front to back, then knit through the back loop with the right needle

SSK (Slip, Slip, Knit): slip the first stitch as if to knit, slip the second stitch as if to knit, then slide the left-hand needle into the front of both stitches and knit them together
