# Turin Cowl by Wool & Co.

EXPERIENCE LEVEL Beginner

Cozy & chic, the Turin Cowl is a quick knit that looks great on everyone. A larger needle gives perfect drape & movement to this two-tone, textural delight that can be worn single or doubled.







# MATERIALS 2 skeins Malabrigo Rasta (90 yards, 100g each) in contrasting or complimentary colors

Sample Yarn Colours 1 skein Malabrigo Rasta Fog (color 1) 1 skein Malabrigo Rasta Cosmos (color 2)

Size US 19, straight or circular needle (or size to obtain gauge)

# Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

6 stitches/ 8 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch knit flat, blocked

### FINISHED SIZE

Scarf circumference measures 58" long x 10" wide

# TECHNIQUES Seaming

# SET-UP

Cowl is knit flat using 1 color at a time. Begin with first color, knit pattern until skein is used, leaving 8' tail to weave in.

With color 1, CO 18 stitches using long tail or preferred cast-on

#### BEGIN PATTERN

Row 1: K2, P3, K5, P3, K5

Row 2: K2, P4, K3, P5, K4

Row 3: K2, P1, K5, P3, K7

Row 4: K3, P5, K3, P5, K2

Row 5: K6, P3, K5, P2, K2

Row 6: K5, P5, K3, P3, K2

Row 7: K4, P3, K5, P3, K3

Row 8: K2, P2, K3, P5, K3, P1, K2

Repeat rows 1-8 until almost entire skein is used, leaving an 8" tail to weave in.

When first skein is used, continue knitting in pattern with color 2.

Repeat rows 1-8, ending with row 8. Be sure to leave enough yarn for bind-off & seaming.

#### **BIND-OFF**

Bind-off stitches, leaving enough yarn to seam.

#### **FINISHING**

Using preferred method, seam the two ends of scarf together to create an infinity cowl.

Weave in ends with tapestry needle Spray or steam block.
