EXCLUSIVE HAND-DYED SUPER SOFT BIELLA PURE CASHMERE FABRIC, WITH HAND-STITCHED BUTTONHOLES & REAL HORN BUTTONS

This super limited edition HBJ07 waistcoat and scarf set design is one of only 4 pieces of its kind made by hand in the entire world this season exclusively for Atelier in New York. It was created from our own modified 19th century 5-button single-breasted waistcoat vest and cravatte scarf pattern from our extensive tailoring research, and cut by hand in a luxurious supersoft houndstooth check Biella pure cashmere combined with a special patchwork lining story of striped viscose and cotton woven for us from Tessitura Mauri in Como. It was then specially individually hand dyed in our studios with a special process which takes over 8 hours for each piece to achieve its unique patina and color effects. Variations in color and color density are not imperfections or irregularities, but specific characteristics of the special hand dyeing technique. The piece also features remarkable real horn buttons made for us in Parma Italy by Claudio and Cinzia Fontana, the greatest living buttonmakers in the world today, and real hand-stitched buttonholes (each one requires 8-10 minutes to cut and sew) in pure silk Bozzolo Reale Milano Seta thread and is handsigned and numbered by the designer. Please treat buttons and buttonholes with care. We recommend professional cleaning or hand wash in cold water and protect buttons with foil or plastic wrap when washing. Do not wash with other items. Do not put in washer or dryer.
