THIS super-limited edition SEP12 trouser design is one of only 3 pieces of its kind made by hand in the entire world exclusively for Atelier in New York. It was created from our oversize fly-front drawstring fisherman's suspenders trouser pattern, from extensive tailoring research, and cut using an exclusive luxury linen, cotton & wool fabric woven exclusively for us in Sarcedo, Vicenza Italy by Luigi Parisotto and family, each individually dyed by hand in our studios using a process that requires over 8 hours of specialized work to achieve its unique color, special patina and effects. The design also features special suspenders made by hand in our studios, elasticized cuff, single front flap-pocket and single rear flap-pocket, reinforced leg panels and remarkable real tinted horn buttons made exclusively for us by Claudio and Cinzia Fontana in Parma Italy, and real hand-stitched buttonholes (each one requires 8-10 minutes to cut and sew) in luxurious pure silk *Bozzolo Reale Seta Milano* threads and is hand-signed and numbered by the designer. Please treat buttons and hand-stitched detail work with care. We recommend professional cleaning or hand wash in cold water and protect buttons with foil or plastic wrap when washing. Do not wash with other items. Do not put in washer or dryer.
