Your new Reynolds Cycling product is warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship for the lifetime of the product. This is a limited warranty, subject to all terms and limitations set forth or referenced below. Proof of purchase is required for any claim made pursuant to this limited warranty.

WARRANTY REQUIREMENTS

This limited warranty is only for the benefit of the original purchaser of the product, and only if the product was purchased from a Reynolds Authorized Dealer or directly from www.reynoldscycling.com. The warranty may not be transferred to any subsequent purchaser or user. You must register the product in order for your limited warranty to take effect. For Warranty Registration, go to www.reynoldscycling.com/support/register and fill out the registration information completely. You will be emailed a receipt of your limited warranty registration.

WARRANTY LIMITATIONS

This warranty is limited to the original owner of applicable Reynolds wheel sets and is not transferrable. If the wheel set was not purchased new from a Reynolds Authorized Dealer or directly from Reynolds at www.reynoldscycling.com, the warranty is void. Further, this warranty does not apply to damage caused by, for example, normal wear and tear, abuse or misuse, alterations or modifications, or use with non-Reynolds equipment – e.g., use of non-Cryo-Blue brake pads for rim brake wheels. In the event repair or replacement of a warranted wheel system is not possible or practical, Reynolds reserves the right to provide the owner with a wheel system that is comparable to the original in all aspects of function, performance and price.

Finally, and as stated above, Reynolds wheels are consistently proven the strongest and most durable carbon fiber wheel systems in the world. However, even the strongest of carbon-based wheel systems are unlikely to survive crashes with automobiles, falls from cliffs or exposure to extreme temperatures. While the Reynolds Limited Lifetime Warranty does not cover such occurrences, Reynolds is pleased to provide a further warranty program that does cover such occurrences and many others. Please see the Reynolds Assurance Program (RAP) for details concerning its no-questions-asked replacement program for those unexpected blows that can ruin even the strongest of carbon-based wheel systems.

WARRANTY CLAIMS

TO MAKE A CLAIM UNDER THIS WARRANTY:

Should service or repair of your Reynolds wheel set become necessary, simply contact your Reynolds Authorized Dealer or contact Reynolds directly using the information below to request a return material authorization number. Then, simply return the wheel set, properly packaged and postage prepaid, along with your proof of purchase, name, address, telephone number, and a description of the claimed defect. Any wheel set which, upon examination by Reynolds staff, is found to be defective will be repaired or replaced with a comparable wheel set without charge. The warranty period for any wheel set repaired or replaced under this limited warranty shall continue throughout the lifetime of the original owner.

- You must obtain a Return Material Authorization (RMA) number issued by Reynolds Cycling
 prior to returning any product. You can request an RMA by completing the warranty claim form
 located on our website at reynoldscycling.com/warranty or by calling Reynolds at 801-565-8003.
- Proof of purchase MUST be provided
- Except as otherwise required by applicable law you will be responsible for shipping or other costs to transport the product to and from Reynolds or a Reynolds Authorized Dealer.
- For a product that is covered under this warranty Reynolds will elect either repair or replacement of the product at no charge; however, if neither repair nor replacement is feasible (as determined by Reynolds), then Reynolds may instead pay you an amount equal to your original purchase price for the product.

If you elect to repair a defective product yourself, if you obtain repair services from someone other than a Reynolds Authorized Dealer, or if you use a replacement part not supplied by Reynolds, then Reynolds

will have no further responsibility for your use of that product, and Reynolds cannot and will not be liable for any damage, failure or loss that may be caused by your own repair efforts or your use of unauthorized parts or service.
