SMITTEN WITH MITTENS – MITTEN DESIGN CONTEST Rules for submission

- Open to all knitters and crocheters.
- This is a "pro-am" design contest, open to both professional and amateur designers, including first-timers.
- All mitten designs entered must be ORIGINAL designs. You may get inspiration from any source, however
 plagiarizing another person's work will result in your entry being disqualified and ineligible for any prize.
 For example, merely changing the color or a few rows of stitches in another person's design is not
 acceptable your work must be SIGNIFICANTLY different from any published work.
- Have fun with this be fun, wacky, creative, and/or inventive. Make a statement!
- All submissions must be completed using the published official Contest Entry Form.
 - The form must be signed and sent in with pattern and mitten pair sample.
 - All finalists' submitted patterns must be typed.
 - Patterns should be tested for accuracy before submission.
 - Please keep close track of the materials that you use, including yarn types, amounts, needles, hooks, and any other accessories. We have provided space on the form for recording your material requirements.
- We ask that you support independent local yarn stores.
- Yarn requirement:
 - No 100% acrylic. Blends are permissible.
 - Easy care yarn, including superwash wool.
 - DK, worsted, chunky yarns only.
- Only mittens, not fingerless mitts or gloves. A mitten is defined as having 2 sections, 1 for the thumb and 1 for all four fingers.
- Any size of mitten is permissible; however, they should be practical for the wearer.
- Sample mittens will be donated to Mittens for Detroit, will not be returned to creator.

Delivery requirements:

- Deadline for submission is 9/22/18. Early submission is allowable.
- Mittens along with submission form must be delivered in an envelope or mailed to The Yarn Stop.
- Incomplete submissions or those received after 9/22/18 will not be considered.
- Postmark date will be considered the submission date.
- Mittens must be delivered or mailed to: The Yarn Stop, 25 S. Main Street, Clawson, MI 48017

Judging criteria:

- All designs must be original and not adaptation of others' patterns.
- Judges will consider:
 - o Design
 - Ease of pattern
 - Appearance
 - Originality
 - o Fit
