

Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 82 sts and work in k1,p1 rib for 4 cm.

Change to 5 mm needles and st st.

When work meas 20 cm after rib, k2 tog to end of row [41 sts]

On foll alt row, k1, then k2 tog to end of row [21 sts]; thread yarn through sts and pull tight.

MAKE UP

Sew hat using concealed stitching.

Make a pom-pom and attach to top of hat.

ONE SIZE

Circum. 48 cm, height 26 cm

MATERIALS

PHIL MIKADO: 1 ball of ARLEQUIN

1 pair each of 3.5 mm (UK - - US 4) and 5 mm (UK 6 - US 8) knitting needles

Composition: 30% combed wool, 70% premium acrylic

STITCHES

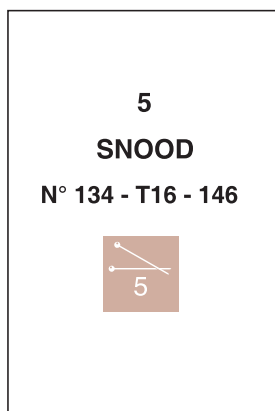
K1,p1 rib

St st

TENSION

Be sure to check your tension before starting to knit. If tension is too tight, change to larger needles; if it is too loose, change to smaller needles.

17 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 5 mm needles



33 sts to 20 cm and and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over patt st using 5 mm needles

Using 5 mm needles, cast on 197 sts and work in patt st (see STITCH).

When work meas 40 cm from beg, cast off all sts.

MAKE UP

Sew snood using concealed stitching.

ONE SIZE

Width 117 cm, height 40 cm

MATERIALS

PHIL MIKADO: 4 balls of ARLEQUIN

1 pair of 5 mm (UK 6 - US 8) knitting needles

Composition: 70% premium acrylic, 30% combed wool

STITCH

Patt st: work on a number of sts multiple of 5 + 2

1st row (RS): *k3, p1, k1*, repeat from * to *, end with k2

2nd row: p2, *k1, p1, k1, p2*, repeat from * to *

These 2 rows form pattern

TENSION

Be sure to check your tension before starting to knit. If tension is too tight, change to larger needles; if it is too loose, change to smaller needles.
