

CHUNKY SCARF



MIRANDA by MASTER KNIT
80% Acrylic, 20% Wool
175 g, 53 yards

KNITTING

HOW TO MAKE IT

MATERIALS:

- Miranda, Master Knit:
3 balls: #632 Navy
- Knitting Needles 10 mm
(15 US)

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 together
p = purl
rep = repeat(s)(ing)
st(s) = stitch(es)
WS = wrong side

STITCH EXPLANATION:

yo (yarn over): An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle.
This creates a new st.

NOTES

- The pattern st creates a diagonal effect causing the ends of the Scarf to slant slightly.
- Length is about 9 1/2 x 70 in. (24 x 178 cm)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Cast on 21 sts loosely.

Row 1 (WS): K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

*Row 2: K3, *yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.*

*Rep Rows 1 and 2 until about 2 yds (2 m) of yarn remains, end with a WS row. Note: End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row.
Bind off.*

Finishing

Weave in ends.
