STRIPED WRAP SCARF



MAR by MASTER KNIT 78% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 2% Viscose 400 g, 875 yards KNITTING

HOW TO MAKE IT

MATERIALS:

Mar, Master Knit:
2 balls: # 110 Wine
2 balls: #736 Purple
Knitting Needles size 5mm (8 US)

NOTES

1. The Scarf is worked in one piece with 2 colors of yarn in Garter st (knit every st on every row).

2. The elongated triangle shape is created by working simple increases and decreases.

3. When you work yarn overs (yo's) you'll increase one stich on Row 1 and one stitch on Row 5. On Row 9, you'll work both a yarn over increase and a k2tog decrease – so your stitch count will not change.

INSTRUCTIONS:

With A, cast on 4 sts.

Knit 2 rows.

Row 1 (right side): K2, yo, knit to end of

row – you'll now have 5 sts.

Rows 2-4: Knit.

Row 5: K2, yo, k to end of row - 6 sts.

Rows 6-8: Knit.

Row 9: K2, yo, k to last 4 sts, k2tog,

k2 - 6 sts.

Rows 10-12: Knit.

With A, rep Rows 1-12 for 7 more times. You'll have a total of 20 sts, and the last row you worked will have been a wrong side row.

Stripes

Note: When working stripes, you'll be working 2 rows with each color of yarn. No need to cut yarn between color changes, just carry the color you're not using along the side edge of the piece.

With B, rep Rows 1 and 2. With A, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Continue in this way, repeating Rows 1-12 of pattern and alternating 2 rows of A with 2 rows of B, until you have 60 sts on your needle and have just finished working Row 8 of pattern. Cut A.

With B only, rep Rows 9-12 of pattern, then rep Rows 1-12 once more. Knit one row, then bind off all sts loosely and as if to knit.

Finishing Weave in ends.



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
